The Oregon Dairy Princess-Ambassador Program started in 1959 and has been promoting the dairy industry and assisting in the development of young women since that time.

Interested in becoming a Dairy Princess-Ambassador?

You must be at least 17 years old and a senior in high-school but no older than 23 years of age as of June 1, AND fulfilled one of the following requirements:

- ◆ 4-H or FFA member who had a dairy cattle project or projects, including raising a heifer dairy calf to the point of milk production.
- ◆ The daughter of any person presently employed full-time as owner or employee of a milk processing plant or milk distributor.
- ◆ Lived or worked on a dairy farm or facility at some time during your life.
- ◆ You are the daughter of any person employed full-time on an operating dairy farm.

In addition, you must be single and have never been married or had children; and if not living at home, you must not be currently cohabitating.

Eligibility will be determined by the Oregon Dairy Women.
